
INTRODUCTION

PREPARING TO USE

Remove the top of the vacuum by releasing the side latches.

Fig. 2 With both latches released, lift the top section away as shown.

HOW TO ASSEMBLE

Remove tube sections and tools from inside the vacuum cleaner

Assemble the three piece extension tubes and the floor tool by pushing them together as shown.

Fig. 5 VACUUM - Insert flexible hose into hole labelled 'vacuum'

Fig. 6 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{BLOWER}}$ - Insert the flexible hose into the hole labelled 'blow'

HOW TO USE

Fully unwind the electrical cable and plug it into a standard domestic power outlet.

To start the vacuum cleaner, turn the power switch on. To stop, turn the switch off.

OPERATING YOUR CLEANER

Ensure black fibre filter bag is fitted and secured using the elastic band supplied.

Wet Fig. 10

Remove black fibre filter bag, exposing safety float chamber.

Floor tool is suitable for wet or dry use.

Fig. 12

Hand tool is suitable for wet or dry use.

Important

Ensure there is no remaining water in the hose and tubes before switching off the appliance.

EMPTYING THE DUST CONTAINER/DIRTY WATER CONTAINER

For dry- empty dust and debris directly into the bin. For wet- tip the dirty water down sink or drain, rinse out the container.

CLEANING THE FILTER

Motor protection filter

The black fibre filter bag is located on the underside of the top section and protects the motor from dust and debris during dry vacuuming.

This filter can be removed and lightly rinsed under cold water to remove any debris. Ensure it is completely dry before replacing.

Attention: The black fibre filter bag must always be used when dry vacuuming.

Tube sections and tools can be stored inside the vacuum cleaner.

When not in use, the flexible tube can be stored as shown.

- IMPORTANT NOTES/TROUBLESHOOTING
- If the suction is significantly reduced, the filter may require cleaning.
- During wet vacuuming, if the float rises and blocks suction, you will notice the change in the sound that the machine makes. This is a safety feature and is intended to prevent continued use when the recovery tank is full of liquid. Switch off the appliance, empty the liquid, reassemble and then restart.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always remove the re-useable black fibre filter bag before wet vacuuming.
- Do not dry vacuum without the re-useable black fibre filter bag in place.
- Ensure that all accessories, filter and extension tubes are thoroughly dry before dry vacuuming.
- The plug must be removed from the mains socket outlet before cleaning or maintaining the appliance.
- If the mains cable and /or plug is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons, in order to avoid hazard.

GENERAL SAFETY INFORMATION

- Note: this product must be stored indoors.
- Not to be used as a toy.
- Use the appliance only as described in this manual.
- Use only the accessories recommended by the manufacturer.
- Do not use the appliance with a damaged mains cable or plug.
- Do not use the appliance if it has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors or dropped in water.

Never pull the appliance by the mains cable.

Do not pull on the cable to disconnect the appliance from the mains supply. Always use the plug.

- Keep the mains cable and appliance away from sources of heat.
- Do not handle the mains cable, plug or appliance with wet hands.
- Ensure that no foreign bodies can get into the openings of the appliance.
- Do not use the appliance if the openings are blocked. Keep them free from dust, fluff, hair and any other material that might cause a restriction of the air flow.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers and any other parts of the body away from any moving parts.
- Do not pick up burning or smoking objects such as cigarettes, matches or hot ashes.
- Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids such as petrol, or use in areas where they may be present.
- Do not change accessories while the appliance is operating.
- Always store the appliance indoors. To avoid accidents, put the appliance away safely after use.
